Deliveries

- Collect and verify delivery instructions.
- Ensure the safe, accurate and timely loading and delivery of fertilizer, notifying the Supervisor of any product, quality or delivery issues.
- Carry out inspections of the product during loading and delivery, reporting issues and questions of quality to the Supervisor prior to unloading or delivery.
- Maneuver trucks into loading or unloading positions, following signals from loading crew as needed.
- Report spills to the Supervisor and ensure their efficient clean up.
- Maintain the accuracy of documentation and paperwork.
- Complete and submit all documentation required at end of shift. May include but not limited to, timesheets, daily logs, bill of lading, hours of service, vehicle inspection, etc.
- Work with customers and suppliers in a courteous and professional manner.
- Perform other duties as assigned;
- Work additional hours to meet business demands.

- Provide exceptional and courteous customer service.

Health and Safety

- Perform daily pre and post trip vehicle inspections for mechanical and safety issues (circle check) and perform preventative maintenance.

- Operate only equipment and machinery for which training has been received, in a safe and effective manner;
